

RESOLUTION NO. 608 CMS

DECLARING THAT THE WEEK OF JULY 7-12, 1969 BE DESIGNATED "OBERLIN MUSIC THEATER WEEK.

WHEREAS, Oberlin Music Theater has the potential for becoming a national training ground for young performing artists, providing them with much needed stage experience which, until now, they have been forced to seek abroad, and

WHEREAS, Oberlin Music Theater presents the opportunity for the performance of important new works by American composers, and

WHEREAS, Oberlin Music Theater promises to become a valuable cultural addition to the northeastern Ohio area, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin looks forward to the continuation of good music and theater throughout the summer, and to welcoming audiences from neighboring communities,


NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the week of July 7-12, 1969, be designated "Oberlin Music Theater Week" in said City and that all residents be urged to make a special effort to lend their support to Oberlin Music Theater and to welcome its audiences.


