

RESOLUTION NO. 609 CMS

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF A WATER LINE TO THE LOCATION OF THE LORAIN COUNTY JOINT VOCATIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT'S PROPOSED BUILDING AND DECLARING THE SAME AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, there has been created a Lorain County Joint Vocational School District, and

WHEREAS, said District is in the process of acquiring a site for the construction of a building near Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of said Lorain County Joint Vocational School District has requested the City of Oberlin to furnish water to said proposed school building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths of all duly elected or appointed members thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin agree to furnish water to the proposed site of said Lorain County Joint Vocational School District under the following terms and conditions if said site is outside the city limits:

- (a) That said water be furnished by contract as to price and quantity.
- (b) That the extension be made only according to the plans and specifications prepared by the City Engineer, and made only if engineering studies show same to be feasible.
- (c) That the entire cost of the extension be at the expense of the Lorain County Joint Vocational School District including any additional size as prescribed by the City up to 12" in pipe size.
- (d) That the line upon installation becomes the property of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.
- (e) That in the event said pipe is laid within a road right-of-way outside the City of Oberlin, and a relocation is required, the Lorain County Joint Vocational School District will pay the entire cost of relocating said line unless the area has been annexed to the City of Oberlin.
- (f) the Lorain County Joint Vocational School District shall do all in its power to have its territory annexed to the City of Oberlin.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide school facilities for its citizens and shall take effect immediately upon passage."
