

RESOLUTION NO. 632 CMS

APPROVING TRANSFER OF FUNDS

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,  
Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members  
elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the City Auditor be and he is hereby em-  
powered to transfer all unexpended balances in the various accounts  
of the City Funds to the surplus account in each respective fund and  
to transfer from the surplus account in each fund the exact amount  
needed to cover any deficit in the various fund accounts without,  
however, transferring from one fund to another.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be in full force and  
effect from the earliest period allowed by law.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Martin Luther King, distinguished clergyman and dedicated civil rights leader, was assassinated on April 14, 1968, and

WHEREAS, the ideals and philosophy which he fostered for justice, brotherhood, love and peace through non-violent action have yet to be achieved, and


WHEREAS, the founders and early settlers of Oberlin pronounced these same goals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Oberlin, Ohio, in recognition of the birthdate of Dr. King, hereby declares January 15, 1971 as a day for the citizens of this community to reflect on our attitudes in human relations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Human Relations Commission shall urge schools, churches, and other organizations to conduct, on or about this date, programs appropriate for the occasion.
