

RESOLUTION NO. 616 CMS

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF INTENT
BETWEEN OBERLIN COLLEGE, THE JOINT TOWNSHIP
HOSPITAL BOARD, THE CITY OF OBERLIN AND ALLEN
MEMORIAL HOSPITAL ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, there has been presented to the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, on January 19, 1970, a proposed Memorandum of Intent concerning the enlargement and expansion of Allen Memorial Hospital, and

WHEREAS, said Memorandum of Intent has been approved by Oberlin College.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the proposed Memorandum of Intent as presented to the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, on January 19, 1970, be and the same is hereby approved and the City Manager authorized to sign said Memorandum of Intent.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:


To provide needed hospital facilities,
