## RESOLUTION NO. 610 CMS

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE REPORT OF THE OBERLIN PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION CONCERNING ADDITIONAL POWER REQUIREMENTS FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN,

WHEREAS, W. Vance Middough and Associates have submitted a survey and recommendations for the Oberlin Municipal Light and Power Depart, ant dated December 15, 1969, and

WHEREAS, Ohio Edison Company has submitted a proposal to provide power on an additional basis to the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Public Utilities Commission has made a reconmendation to the City Council of Oberlin to accept the Obio Edison Company offer of additional power and W. Vance Middough and Associates have made a recommendation to use Ohio Edison Company as additional power source together with a new substation and a loop tie in line rather than to provide additional generating power at the existing light plant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the written report of the Glerlin Public Utilities Commission dated the 15th day of February, 1970, is herewith approved.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, the Superintendent of the Light Flant and the City Solicitor are hereby directed to enter into formal negotiations with the Ohio Edison Company for a contract in accordance with the terms of the letter from the Ohio Edison Company dated January 23, 1970 to W. Vance Middough and Associates.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is hereby directed to orgage the services of W. Vance Middough and Associates to prapare the plans and specifications for the substation as proposed in their report dated December 15, 1969, as well as the loop service line proposed in said report.

SECTION 4. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
