RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION

The Council of City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 10th day of September, 1970, at the ~~office of the~~ Council Chambers

with the following members present:

Mr. JACKSON moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of City of Oberlin

for the purpose of providing additional funds for the payment of the Police Pension Fund requirements

at a rate not exceeding (.30) .3 ^(Mrs. Howard) _{3/10ths} mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.003

for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for the years 1970, 1971, 1972, 1973 and 1974 and which levy is a renewal of an existing levy of .30 mills on each dollar of the tax valuation of the taxable property within the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio.

"and which levy is a renewal or part of an existing levy, being a reduction of mills to constitute a tax of mills."

RESOLVED, That said levy be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of this Council of the City of Oberlin, be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Lorain County, Ohio, prior to the 15th day of September, 1970

and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
