

RESOLUTION NO. 626

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN ASSESSMENT EQUALIZATION BOARD TO HEAR OBJECTIONS RELATIVE TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF MORGAN STREET BETWEEN CERTAIN TERMINI BY GRADING, CONSTRUCTING CURBS AND GUTTERS AND PAVING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Edward Sable, George Goodson and William Stetson, three disinterested freeholders of said City be and they are hereby appointed to act as an Assessment Equalization Board to hear and determine all timely written objections to the estimated assessments heretofore reported to this Council of the cost of improving Morgan Street from Pyle-South Amherst Road easterly a distance of approximately 1,400 feet by grading, constructing curbs and gutters and paving, and to equalize the same as to them seems proper, in accordance with law and with Resolution No. 622 CMS, adopted by this Council on June 15, 1970.

Section 2. The Board shall first meet for the above purpose at 7:30 p.m. Eastern Standard Time in Ohio (Fast Time) on the 29th day of August, 1970, in Council Chambers, Oberlin City Hall, 69 South Main Street, Oberlin, Ohio, and upon the completion of such equalization shall report such equalized assessment to Council.

Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said City, and for the further reason that the immediate construction of said improvement is necessary to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrian and vehicular traffic; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage.
