APPROVING THE WORKABLE PROGRAM SUBMITTED BY THE
CITY OF OBERLIN,
OHIO

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin recognizes an obligation to the general welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to create a comfortable and pleasant living environment in all areas of the community through the use of public and private resources, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City of Oberlin to develop and administer a Workable Program for community improvement by use of all available resources, both public and private,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, **5/7ths of all members elected thereto concurring**


SECTION 1. That the Workable Program be and the same is hereby approved and said report authorized to be submitted to the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law, and for the following purpose, to-wit:
