- WHEREAS, the city of Oberlin looks forward to the continuation of good music and theater throughout the summer,
- BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the city of Oberlin,
 Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto
 concurring:
- SECTION I. That the week of July 7-12, 1971, be designated as "Oberlin Music Theater Week" in said city and that all residents be urged to make a special effort to lend their support to Oberlin Music Theater and to welcome its audiences.
