RESOLUTION NO. 640 CMS

DECLARING THAT THE WEEK OF JULY 7-12, 1971 BE DESIGNATED
"OBERLIN MUSIC THEATER WEEK"

WHEREAS, Oberlin Music Theater is a valuable cultural addition to the northeastern Ohio area, and

WHEREAS, the city of Oberlin looks forward to the continuation of good music and theater throughout the summer,

BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the city of Oberlin, Ohio, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That the week of July 7-12, 1971, be designated as "Oberlin Music Theater Week" in said city and that all residents be urged to make a special effort to lend their support to Oberlin Music Theater and to welcome its audiences.
