Mr. Johnson moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said

City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the Council of the

County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of

City of Oberlin

for the purpose of providing additional funds for capital improvements for the City of Oberlin

at a rate not exceeding 2.5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.025

for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for the years 1971, 1972, 1973, 1974, 1975

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of this Council of the City of Oberlin be and he is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections,

Lorain County, Ohio, prior to the 15th day of September 1971

and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.
