

A RESOLUTION FOR CERTAIN MINUTES OF THE  
CITY COUNCIL TO BE PLACED IN STORAGE WITH  
THE OBERLIN COLLEGE ARCHIVES.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has minutes of their meetings for many years past, and in particular for the years 1890 to 1940 inclusive; and;

WHEREAS, it is determined by this Council that said City Council meeting minutes are not needed for preservation by the city government,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the minutes and other papers of historic value of the City Council meetings from the years 1890 to 1940 inclusive, be deposited in the Oberlin College Archives to be kept by them for historical purposes.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
