

A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE CITY RECYCLING PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin during part of 1971 has operated a recycling program for paper, glass, and cans, and;

WHEREAS, said program has been a moderate success;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby directed to extend the City Recycling Program for the year 1972.

SECTION 2. There is herewith appropriated the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) as funds for the expenses of said recycling program.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage, due to the fact that it is an emergency factor, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"To reduce or eliminate trash."
