

RESOLUTION NO. 658 CMS

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LORAIN COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SELLING WATER TO CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED AREAS IN LORAIN COUNTY.

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Commissioners have requested that the Oberlin City Council consider the sale of water to Lorain County on a bulk basis; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has studied this matter at length; Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That the Council of the City of Oberlin does hereby express its interest and intent to sell water to the Lorain County Commissioners.

SECTION II. That the following individuals are hereby appointed as negotiating committee to negotiate with the Lorain County Commissioners for the purpose of negotiating a contract to be submitted to the Oberlin City Council for approval.
