

RESOLUTION NO. 660

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THE PROMOTION OF INDUSTRIAL AND OPEN SPACE DEVELOPMENT IS NECESSARY FOR THE PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF OBERLIN, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is in dire need of industrial and open space development; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Oberlin hereby determines that the promotion of industrial development and open space development is of extreme benefit to the citizens of Oberlin; Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION I. That for the purpose of said industrial and open space development, there is herewith reserved, an amount of Councilmanic Bonds in the amount of \$150,000, which may be issued by the City of Oberlin for any proper and satisfactory industrial open space development program or programs.

SECTION II. This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
