
RESOLUTION URGING CITY-WIDE VOTE FOR THE SALE OF LIQUOR

BE IT HERE RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Oberlin strenuously objects to a recent action in Oberlin to allow the question of the sale of liquor in the City to be decided only by two precincts.

THE CITY COUNCIL further expressed the view that since the liquor issue is important to all the citizens, and to insure the security of participatory democracy, the issue should be decided on a city-wide vote.
