RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FILING OF APPLICATION
FOR STREET ASSISTANCE FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF
PARK STREET PARK

PROJECT TITLE: PARK STREET PARK DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Act 1964 (Public Law 88-578) provides financial assistance to the State of Ohio for outdoor recreation purposes, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, desires financial assistance under the Land and Water Conservation Fund Act program:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Oberlin as follows:

1. That the City of Oberlin hereby approves filing an Application for Land and Water Conservation Fund Act financial assistance.
2. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Department of Natural Resources, State of Ohio, and to provide all information and documentation required in said application for submission to the Federal Bureau of Outdoor Recreation.
3. That the City of Oberlin hereby does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and thus become eligible for Land and Water Conservation Fund Act financial aid of 50% of the actual allowable reimbursement cost.
