

RESOLUTION NO. 674 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
SUBMIT THE FINAL DESIGN PLANS FOR THE WASTE
WATER TREATMENT PLANT OF OBERLIN TO THE
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR FINANCING

WHEREAS, Burgess and Niple, consulting engineers of
Columbus, Ohio, have submitted to the City of Oberlin, Ohio,
final design plans dated May, 1972, for the Oberlin Waste Water Treat-
ment Plant, and

WHEREAS, the said plans have been approved by the Ohio
Department of Health,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City
of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the City Manager, Thomas Dalton, is hereby
authorized in the name of the City of Oberlin, to submit said plans to
the Environmental Protection Agency for financing purposes,

SECTION 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit:

"To expedite the construction of the Waste Water
Treatment Plant of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take
effect immediately upon passage."
