

RESOLUTION NO. 684 CMS

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENT OF CITY COUNCIL
TO ABANDON FOR FUTURE USE THE AREA OF WESTWOOD
CEMETERY KNOWN AS "POTTER'S FIELD"

WHEREAS, a portion of Westwood Cemetery known as "Potter's Field" has been and is presently being used for the burial of indigent persons, and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to dispense with said "Potter's Field" as a separate burial area in order to eliminate discrimination based on wealth.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the use of "Potter's Field" as a separate burial area for indigent persons, be and the same is hereby abandoned.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period provided by law.
