A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SENATE BILL 215
AMENDING THE OHIO CODE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elec-
ted thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. We, the members of the Oberlin City Council,
do support the proposed amendment to Section 11303 of the Ohio
Revised Code in Senate Bill 215. We further urge the passage of
this bill both by the Ways and Means Committee and the Senate as
a whole.


SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an
