

RESOLUTION NO. 690 CMS

A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
BILL 1508 ESTABLISHING ECONOMIC EQUITY FOR PRODUCTS  
MADE WITH RECYCLED MATERIALS

WHEREAS, the principle of tax depletion allowance is currently applied to the extraction of certain materials from our natural resources, and

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives is currently considering a bill which will establish the same principle for recycled materials, and

WHEREAS, it is beneficial for recycled materials to be used in place of virgin materials,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. We, the members of the Oberlin City Council; do support the proposed bill HR 1508 of the United States House of Representatives. We urge the passage of this bill both for the House Ways and Means Committee and the House of Representatives as a whole.

SECTION 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio.
