

RESOLUTION NO. 694 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
ACCEPT THE FEDERAL GRANT OFFER TO ASSIST FINANC-
ING IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE WASTE WATER TREATMENT
PLANT OF OBERLIN, OHIO

WHEREAS, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has
approved an application from the City of Oberlin for a Federal Sewage
Works Grant in the amount of \$1,335,750 and tendered an offer of
financial assistance, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is desirous of constructing
improvements to its Waste Water Treatment Plant to control water
pollution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City
of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all mem-
bers elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager, Thomas D. Dalton, is
hereby authorized in the name of the City of Oberlin, to accept said
offer of financial assistance,


SECTION 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit:

"To expedite the construction of the Waste Water
Treatment Plant of Oberlin, Ohio, and shall take
effect immediately upon passage."
