## RESOLUTION NO. 705 CMS

## A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE TRUCKERS STRIKE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Oberlin City Council condemns the violence, threats of violence, and other unlawful interference with the free flow of commercial traffic on the public roads and highways of our County and State. While recognizing the frustrations of some truckers under present conditions, we urge them to cope with problems only through legal means. We call upon local, county, and state law enforcement officers to use their total resources in ensuring the rights of all citizens to unimpeded use of roads and highways.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
