

RESOLUTION NO. 711 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT DOCUMENTS TO SUBSTANTIATE COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 206 (a) OF THE FEDERAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF THE COST OF THE PLUM CREEK INTERCEPTOR SANITARY SEWER

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin desiring to eliminate random polluttional discharges into Plum Creek by way of sub-standard sanitary sewerage has constructed a 24" interceptor sewer along Plum Creek within the City of Oberlin, and

WHEREAS, the City has substantially complied with the Federal requirements for bid awards and had obtained approval for the project from the State of Ohio,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager, Thomas D. Dalton, is hereby authorized in the name of the City of Oberlin to submit documents, plans and other necessary information to the Federal Environmental Protection Agency to determine the eligibility and substantiate construction cost for reimbursement as authorized under Section 206 (a) of P.L. 93-207.

SECTION 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To secure Federal financial assistance for the construction of sewerage treatment work in the City of Oberlin and shall take effect immediately upon passage".
