

RESOLUTION NO. 712 CMS

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE WEEK OF
OCTOBER 14-18, 1974, BE DESIGNATED AS WHITE
CANE SAFETY WEEK

WHEREAS, The President of the United States of America has declared October 15, 1974, as White Cane Safety Day, and

WHEREAS, those blessed with the gift of good eyesight, should be constantly aware of the significance of the white cane, and without hesitation extend every courtesies to those who carry it.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the week of October 14-18, 1974, be designated as "White Cane Safety Week" in said City, and that all residents mark the occasion by giving greater consideration to the special needs of the visually handicapped, and particularly by learning to heed the white cane in order that our visually handicapped may use our streets and public facilities with maximum safety.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon passage.
