

RESOLUTION NO. 714 CMS

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO PROVIDE SITE FOR
CITY HALL COMPLEX AND HOUSING FOR THE ELDERLY

WHEREAS, the Oberlin City Council did request of the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority the construction of fifty units of housing for senior citizens within the boundaries of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority did comply with the request and submitted an application for the aforesaid housing to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has authorized the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority to secure proposals for the aforementioned housing,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oberlin City Council offer a site on City property on South Main Street for the construction of the fifty units of housing for senior citizens to be constructed in conjunction with facilities for City government use, providing such a complex can be consummated legally, and in the best interest of all parties concerned, both economically and socially, as well as mutually functional.
