

RESOLUTION NO. 718 CMS

A RESOLUTION URGING THE SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATION IN A HUNGER OLYMPICS WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN

WHEREAS, a shortage of food is one of the most pressing concerns of the world today and,

WHEREAS, the Christian Rural Overseas Program (CROP), the Community Appeal of Church World Service sends food to children and gives hungry people a chance for a change in more than thirty countries and,

WHEREAS, the youth of Oberlin will participate in a hunger olympics on Monday, January 27, 1975, in order to raise funds for CROP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Oberlin endorses the hunger olympics.

SECTION 2. That Council urges the support and participation in the hunger olympics of all Oberlinians.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
