

RESOLUTION NO. 719 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO APPLY TO THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECT-
ION AGENCY FOR A SEWER CONSTRUCTION REIM-
BURSEMENT GRANT

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin constructed an interceptor
sanitary sewer in the vicinity of Plum Creek in 1969, and

WHEREAS, the project is eligible for a Federal Sewer Con-
struction Reimbursement Grant authorized by Section 206 (a) of the
Water Pollution Control Act of 1972,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City
of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members
elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager, Thomas Dalton, is hereby
authorized in the name of the City of Oberlin, to submit an applica-
tion to the Environmental Protection Agency for reimbursement of up
to one-half of the construction costs.

SECTION 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be
an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the
public peace, property and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio,
to-wit:

"To expedite the application for reimbursement in
order to meet expiration date established by the
U.S. Environmental Protection Agency",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
