

RESOLUTION NO. 722 CMS

A RESOLUTION URGING THE SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATION IN A WORLD HUNGER CONFERENCE WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN

WHEREAS, a shortage of food is one of the most pressing concerns of the world today, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Oberlin should concern themselves with helping to solve the world hunger problem, and

WHEREAS, a conference to study such problems will be held April 25th and April 26th at the First Church of Oberlin.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring.

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Oberlin endorses the World Hunger Conference.

SECTION 2. That the Council of the City of Oberlin urges the support and participation in the World Hunger Conference of all Oberlinians.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
