

RESOLUTION NO. 726 CMS

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A SIDEWALK PROGRAM FOR THE
CITY OF OBERLIN FOR THE YEAR 1975

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County,
State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That it is the intent of the Council of the City of
Oberlin to initiate in 1975 a three-part program dealing with sidewalk repair
and construction. The three-part program shall be as follows:

- (a) Maintenance and repair of all sidewalks that are
the responsibility of the City of Oberlin.
- (b) Construction of new sidewalks on South Pleasant
Street from the end of the existing sidewalk to
Hamilton Street and West College Street from the
end of the existing sidewalk to West Lorain Street.
- (c) Enforcement of Chapter 905 of the Codified Ordinances
of the City of Oberlin dealing with repair and
maintenance of existing sidewalks in residential and
commercial areas.


SECTION 2. That the financial responsibility for subparagraphs
(a) & (b) in Section 1 above shall be that of the City of Oberlin and the
financial responsibility of subparagraph (c) above shall be that of the
abutting landowners, for cost of materials only. This Resolution is con-
tingent upon Oberlin's participation in the CETA program.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest
date allowed by law.
