

RESOLUTION NO. 729 CMS

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO.  
726 CMS, ESTABLISHING A SIDEWALK PRO-  
GRAM FOR THE CITY OF OBERLIN FOR THE  
YEAR 1975

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Resolution No. 726 CMS passed June 16, 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That it is the intent of the Council of the City of Oberlin to initiate in 1975 a three-part program dealing with sidewalk repair and construction. The three-part program shall be as follows:

- (a) Maintenance and repair of all sidewalks that are the responsibility of the City of Oberlin.
- (b) Enforcement of Chapter 905 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Oberlin dealing with repair and maintenance of existing sidewalks in residential and commercial areas.
- (c) Construction of new sidewalks/<sup>and aprons for presently unpaved</sup> on residential driveway aprons: South Pleasant Street from the end of the existing sidewalk to Hamilton Street and West College Street from the end of the existing sidewalk to West Lorain Street."

SECTION 2. That Section 2 of Resolution 726 CMS is amended to read as follows:


"Section 2. That the financial responsibility for subparagraphs (a) & (c) in Section 1 above shall be that of the City of Oberlin and the financial responsibility of subparagraph (b) above shall be that of the abutting landowners, for cost of materials only. This Resolution is contingent upon Oberlin's participation in the CETA program."

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
