

RESOLUTION NO. 732 CMS

A RESOLUTION DECLARING OCTOBER 7, 1975 HEAD START
DAY IN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Head Start plans, conducts and administers a high quality education program for children of pre-school age; and

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Head Start makes available such high quality education programs and related activities to children of pre-school age without undue financial hardship; and

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Head Start develops and implements education programs designed to bring together children from different economic, racial religious and ethnic backgrounds in such a manner that the children may have a positive education experience which will enable them to become responsible adults who lack prejudice and discriminatory attitudes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That Tuesday, October 7, is officially declared Head Start Day within the City of Oberlin.


SECTION 2. That the Council of the City of Oberlin extends its thanks to the staff of the Oberlin Head Start for a job well done.
