A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING MUNICIPAL  
RECYCLING PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, a number of municipalities throughout the country have adopted viable, on-going recycling programs, and;

WHEREAS, recycling programs offer practical alternatives to the current depletion of the Country's tree reserves, and;

WHEREAS, modern technical advances in certain recycling programs offer alternatives to the further depletion of natural gas for industrial use:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, Lorain County, a majority of those members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Oberlin, strongly supports the innovative efforts of certain cities and private companies in establishing various recycling programs throughout the nation.
