RESOLUTION NO. 743 CMS

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF AN ADDI-TIONAL TAX LEVY FOR CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE OBERLIN PUBLIC LIBRARY PURSUANT TO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.19

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Public Library Board, a Public Library supported by the City of Oberlin, has submitted to the Council of the City of Oberlin by a motion adopted August 12, 1976 by a two-thirds (2/3rds) vote of all of its members, a request that this Council submit to the electors of the City of Oberlin the question of an additional tax levy of two (2) mills for current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library, and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.19, Revised Code, authorizes this Council to submit to a vote of the electors the additional levy;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, five-sevenths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the City of Oberlin, for the purpose of providing funds to meet the current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library within the City of Oberlin at a rate not exceeding two (2) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 20 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for each of the years of 1976, 1977, 1978, 1979 and 1980.

SECTION 2. That said levy shall be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

SECTION 3. That the form of the ballot to be cast at the election on November 2, 1976, on the question of this tax levy shall be as follows:

Proposed Tax Levy (Additional)
Oberlin City

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

An additional tax for the benefit of the City of Oberlin for the purpose of current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library at a rate not exceeding two (2) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 20 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for five years.

SECTION 4. That the Clerk of the Council of the City of Oberlin be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Electors, Lorain County, Elyria, Ohio, prior to the 25th day of August, 1976, and notify said Board of Elections to cause Notice of Election on the question of levying said tax be given as required by law.

SECTION 5. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit: to meet the time requirements of Section 5705.19, Revised Code, and to provide funds necessary for the continued operation of the Public Library, and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
