A RESOLUTION URGING THE SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATION
IN A CROP WALK AGAINST HUNGER WITHIN THE CITY OF
OBERLIN

WHEREAS, the Christian Rural Overseas Program (CROP), the Community Appeal of Church World Service sends food to children and gives hungry people a chance for a change in more than thirty countries and,

WHEREAS, the youth and adults of Oberlin will participate in the CROP WALK on Saturday, April 23, 1977, in order to raise funds for CROP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Oberlin endorses the CROP WALK.


SECTION 2, That Council urges the support and participation in the CROP WALK of all Oberlinians.
