

RESOLUTION NO. 749 CMS  
A RESOLUTION DECLARING ADEQUACY OF LAND FOR THE  
CONSTRUCTION OF OFFICE SPACE AND DECLARING AN  
INTENT NOT TO APPROPRIATE CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has initiated a construction project providing for the renovation of the Fisher Building for Municipal Court and Finance Office purposes, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin by Ordinance No. 1267 AC CMS has purchased property at 93 South Main Street for the purpose of constructing further City offices, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by this Council that the space provided at 93 South Main is adequate for current City needs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the current Administrative office needs for the City of Oberlin can be met by existing and proposed buildings located or to be located on the properties of 69 South Main Street, 91 South Main Street and 93 South Main Street.

SECTION 2. That it is the intent of this City Council not to appropriate further land for the construction of City office buildings.


SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
