

RESOLUTION NO. 771 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO INITIATE AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDS FROM THE FARMER'S HOME ADMINISTRATION TO FINANCE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM AND FUNDS TO RE-FINANCE THE PRESENT INDEBTEDNESS OF THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Council of Oberlin desire to obtain monies to finance improvements to the water distribution system and also monies to re-finance the water treatment plant's present indebtedness, and


WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the City Manager to initiate application for these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager be and is hereby authorized and directed to initiate, upon behalf of the City of Oberlin, an application for funds from the Farmer's Home Administration to finance improvements to the water distribution system and funds to re-finance the water treatment plant's present indebtedness.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
