older neighborhoods.

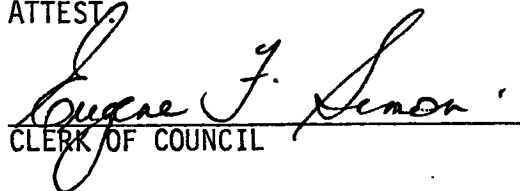
NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin,
