

RESOLUTION NO. 779 CMS

A RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO COOPERATE WITH LOCAL GENERAL PURPOSE GOVERNMENTS IN LORAIN COUNTY IN SUPPORTING THE LORAIN COUNTY RESOURCE RECOVERY PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, there is a critical need to utilize alternative energy resources to promote energy self-sufficiency in Lorain County and the United States; and

WHEREAS, there is a critical need to implement alternative solid waste disposal methods for Lorain County based on limited life of the County's only landfill; and

WHEREAS, the development of resource recovery for Lorain County is the number one priority in the NOACA/OEPA solid waste contract for Northeast Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Energy, Urban Wastes and Municipal Systems Branch has indicated their willingness to consider funding an unsolicited proposal for resource recovery for Lorain County;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:


SECTION 1. That the City of Oberlin, Ohio supports the Lorain County Resource Recovery Proposal prepared by the Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency.

SECTION 2. That the City of Oberlin, Ohio agrees to cooperate with NOACA and other units of government in development of a resource recovery program for Lorain County.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
