

RESOLUTION NO. 785 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF OBERLIN TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR FEDERAL GRANT ASSISTANCE TO AID IN THE AND CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERAGE FACILITIES: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council deems it necessary that the City Manager make application for a Federal Grant Assistance to aid in the Financing and construction of Sanitary Sewerage Facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain and State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That by virtue of the laws of the State of Ohio, it is necessary that the City of Oberlin construct sanitary sewerage improvements for the purpose of pollution abatement in said City and therefore the City Manager of the City of Oberlin is hereby authorized and directed to execute and make application in proper form for Federal Assistance in the financing and construction of said project.


SECTION 2. That said City will, if granted Federal Assistance as applied for, pay the remaining cost of the approved project, and will provide proper and efficient operation and maintenance of the approved project after the completion of construction thereof.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin and for the purpose of acquiring funds for improvements to the sanitary sewerage system for the community.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
