

RESOLUTION NO. 794 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR TO COMPUTE AND MAKE APPROPRIATE ADJUSTMENTS IN THE PAY OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City that certain municipal employees, upon promotion, have not been placed in the appropriate higher pay range steps in accordance with City ordinances, and

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is desirous of making the appropriate adjustments as soon as possible in order to comply with the City ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Auditor is directed to review the pay ranges of all employees of the City of Oberlin and where found appropriate, make the necessary adjustments to the pay scale of said employees in accordance with City ordinances, compute the amount of any wage and longevity arrearage that may be found to be due and pay same.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit"

"To insure that the pay received by certain municipal employees coincides with the pay plan as set forth within the ordinances of the City of Oberlin and to avoid the accumulation of pay arrearage",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
