

RESOLUTION NO. 796 CMS

A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO PREPARE AND FILE A PRE-APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL FUNDS FOR HOUSING REHABILITATION, STREET RESURFACING, AND WATER AND SEWER LINE IMPROVEMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin, Ohio, has identified and determined that there exists a need for housing rehabilitation, street resurfacing, and certain water and sewer line improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to conserve, revitalize and stabilize older neighborhoods, and improve the sewer and water distribution systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Oberlin hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to seek Federal "small cities" Comprehensive Community Development Block Grant funds and to prepare and file a pre-application for same.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To insure that the pre-application for Federal housing funds is filed within the period prescribed by Federal regulations",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
