

RESOLUTION NO. 801 CMS

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE AMOUNT OF TAXES THAT MAY BE RAISED BY LEVY AT THE MAXIMUM RATE AUTHORIZED BY LAW WITHOUT A VOTE OF THE ELECTORS TO BE INSUFFICIENT, AND DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF A LEVY IN EXCESS OF SUCH RATE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes this Council to submit to a vote of the electors a levy for said purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, Lorain County, Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the City of Oberlin for the purpose of providing for the collection and disposal of garbage or refuse at a rate not exceeding .7 mills for each One Dollar of valuation which amounts to \$.07 for each One Hundred Dollars of valuation for each of the years 1981, 1982, 1983, 1984 and 1985.

SECTION 2. That said levy is a renewal of an existing levy for 5 years for the purpose of providing for the collection and disposal of garbage and refuse for the City of Oberlin, Ohio, in accordance with Section 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That said levy shall be placed upon the ballot at an election which shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June of 1981, being June 2, 1981.

SECTION 4. That said levy shall be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if 55% of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

SECTION 5. That the Clerk of the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Lorain County, Ohio, prior to the 20th day of March, 1981, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To meet the time requirements of Section 5705.191 of the Ohio Revised Code and shall take effect immediately upon passage".
