

RESOLUTION NO. 805 CMS

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF THE RENEWAL OF A TAX LEVY FOR CURRENT EXPENSES OF THE OBERLIN PUBLIC LIBRARY PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5705.23 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Oberlin Public Library, a public library supported by the City of Oberlin, has submitted to the Council of the City of Oberlin by Resolution adopted February 18, 1981, by a two-thirds vote of all its members, a request that this Council submit to the electors of the City of Oberlin, the question of the renewal of a tax levy of 2 mills for current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library, and

WHEREAS, Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes this Council to submit to a vote of the electors said renewal levy;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Oberlin, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of the City of Oberlin, for the purpose of providing funds to meet the current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library within the City of Oberlin at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for each One Dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$.20 for each One Hundred Dollars of valuation for each of the years 1981, 1982, 1983, 1984 and 1985.

SECTION 2. That said levy is a renewal of an existing levy for five (5) years for the purpose of providing funds to meet the current expenses of the Oberlin Public Library within the City of Oberlin in accordance with Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That said levy shall be placed upon the ballot at an election which shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in June of 1981, being June 2, 1981.

SECTION 4. That said levy shall be placed upon the tax list of the current year after the February settlement next succeeding the election, if a majority of electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof.

SECTION 5. That the Clerk of the Council of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections, Lorain County, Elyria, Ohio, prior to the 20th day of March, 1981, and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax be given as required by law.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To meet the time requirements of Section 5705.23 of the Ohio Revised Code and to provide funds necessary for the continued operation of the Public Library, and shall take effect immediately upon passage".
