

RESOLUTION NO. 818 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LEGAL AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES
IN CONNECTION WITH A COMPLAINT BROUGHT BY THE OHIO CIVIL RIGHTS
COMMISSION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Ohio Civil Rights Commission has filed a complaint against the City of Oberlin alleging an unlawful discriminatory practice, and

WHEREAS, there is a need for legal representation, investigation and other services for the City of Oberlin in connection with the defense of said complaint.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized to represent the City of Oberlin in the complaint brought by the Ohio Civil Rights Commission at City expense, and to have conducted any investigation, depositions or other work that the City Solicitor deems necessary in the defense of said suit.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the citizens of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"To provide immediate legal defense for a pending complaint alleging an unlawful discriminatory practice",

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
