

RESOLUTION NO. 825 CMS

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY TO BE UNFIT AND NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO OFFER SAID PROPERTY FOR SALE OR EXCHANGE.

WHEREAS, the City has certain personal property which it finds to be unfit and not needed for public use, and,

WHEREAS, the City has need of personal property of the same type, and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City that the sale of said personal property be made simultaneously with the purchase of new personal property of the same type,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the following personal property is hereby found to be not needed and unfit for public use:

Fifty-seven 20 foot black aluminum light poles


SECTION 2. That the City is in need of light poles of the same type but of a length of 16 feet and that it is in the best interest of the City to sell, for the best possible price, said 20 foot light poles simultaneously with the purchase of 16 foot poles.


SECTION 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to offer for sale said 20 foot light poles and to seek bids upon 16 foot light poles and to have the selling price for said 20 foot light poles credited against the purchase price of the 16 foot light poles, all in accordance with Sections 721.01 and 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.
