

RESOLUTION NO. 826 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SOLICIT
DONATIONS TO THE CITY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ASSISTING WITH
THE PAYMENT OF MUNICIPAL UTILITY BILLS AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is aware that municipal utility bills of Oberlin residents increase substantailly during the winter months, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin is also aware of the severe recession presently in existence in Lorain County, and,

WHEREAS, because of those factors many residents of the City of Oberlin are having extreme difficulty in paying their utility bills, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin desires to show its concern with the problem,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, 5/7ths of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to send written requests to the citizens of the City of Oberlin asking for monetary donations to the City for the purpose of assisting with the payment of municipal utility bills of Oberlin residents, and to insert said request in the periodic billings of the utility department of the City.

SECTION 2. That any monies collected by the City as a result of said request shall be applied to the municipal utility accounts of Oberlin residents in consultation with the Oberlin Community Services Council.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution is hereby found to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:


"to show concern for increasing municipal utility bills and facilitate payment thereof as soon as possible"
