

RESOLUTION NO. 828 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY SOLICITOR TO REPRESENT THE CITY OF OBERLIN IN THE APPEAL FILED BY THE CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE BEFORE THE OHIO BOARD OF TAX APPEALS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor be and hereby is authorized to represent the City of Oberlin in the Appeal filed by the City of North Ridgeville, Ohio, and presently pending before the Ohio Board of Tax Appeals, to be charged to the City as extraordinary expense.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to provide immediate legal representation for the City for a pending appeal before the Ohio Board of Tax Appeals"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
