

RESOLUTION NO. 829 CMS

A RESOLUTION DISAPPROVING THE APPLICATION OF JACK LESNICK
FOR PLACEMENT OF CERTAIN LAND LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN
IN AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 929.02

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin has received an application from Jack Lesnick to place approximately 79.06 acres of land located within the City in an Agricultural District pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 929.02, and,

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the placing of said land in an Agricultural District will have a substantial adverse effect on the provision of municipal services within the City, efficient use of land within the City, and the orderly growth and development of the City,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, a majority of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the application of Jack Lesnick for the placement of 79.06 acres of land located within the City of Oberlin in an Agricultural District pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Section 929.02 is hereby disapproved.


SECTION 2. That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the applicant and the Auditor of Lorain County, Ohio.


