## RESOLUTION NO. 847 CMS

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LEGAL AND INCIDENTAL EXPENSES IN CONNECTION WITH A LAWSUIT BROUGHT AGAINST THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7ths) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the City Solicitor and his assistant be and hereby are authorized to represent the City of Oberlin, Ohio, in a lawsuit filed by Price Brothers Company against the City of Oberlin and others, to be charged to the City as extraordinary services, and to have conducted any investigations, depositions or other trial preparation work that the City Solicitor deems necessary in the defense of said suit.

SECTION 2. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to-wit:

"to provide for the immediate legal defense for a pending lawsuit"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.
